CIO Report. Mr. Silber noted the Fund is at \$5.4 Billion and as a comparison, the Fund value in February 2016 was approximately \$4.4 Billion. Mr. Silber commented the S&P 500 is now up 53% since early February 2016 which, he said, exceeds expectations in a two-year time period, despite the drawdown in the market transpired in the last week. He said \$775 million has been paid out in benefits since then and the Fund received \$250 million in contributions. Mr. Silber remarked that there has been \$1.5 billion dollars in investment gains in the last 24 months. He commented that last week's market drop was a normal, historical correction. Discussion ensued.

It was moved by Mr. Bell and seconded by Mr. Matson, and unanimously carried, to approve the Fixed Income and Absolute Return Structure.

Mr. Holland noted the manager search would not be necessary.
