The flu is a contagious illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the lungs, throat and nose. The flu affects millions of people each year and can lead to serious illness, or even death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the best way to prevent the flu is by getting vaccinated each year.

Where to get your flu shot

There are several ways you can obtain this year's flu vaccine:

- ▶ Visit your doctor or other network provider.
- ▶ Visit a network Convenience Care Clinic.
- ▶ Visit a select retail pharmacy or contracted flu shot provider.
- ▶ To locate a network provider, visit myuhc.com[®] or call the member phone number listed on your health plan ID card.

Convenience Care Clinics

Convenience Care Clinics are typically located in retail stores and don't require appointments. They provide a limited range of simple care services, including flu shots, subject to primary care physician office visit copayments. Services/treatments offered to patients 18 months of age or older and may vary with each center.
