Election work is non-partisan and provides a great way to more fully participate in the democratic process. You can apply to work as an Election Inspector (must reside in Milwaukee County). These positions are paid: \$130/day. You must attend training, which is also paid. Fluent bilingual (English/ Spanish or English/Hmong) individuals are especially encouraged to apply.
