### Health Insurance Reminders

- **NON-MEDICARE MEMBERS:** (includes retirees, spouse, and/or dependents): If you have elected or are continuing City of Milwaukee health benefits coverage for 2019, you will not receive a new United Healthcare (UHC)/OptumRx card. Contact information for UHC/OptumRx is on the back of your card. Other benefit phone numbers, including UHC/OptumRx are also located on page 20 of the 2019 Retiree Benefits Guide. The ERS does not send out health/prescription drug cards. If you are new to UHC/OptumRx for 2019 and do not receive a new UHC/OptumRx card by December 31<sup>st</sup>, please contact UHC directly at **1-800-841-4901**.
- **MEDICARE MEMBERS:** If you are continuing City of Milwaukee health benefits coverage and prescription drug coverage through UHC and UHC MedicareRx Part D for 2019, you will not receive a new UHC or UHC MedicareRx Part D cards for 2019. If you are new to UHC and UHC MedicareRx Part D for 2019 you will receive two new cards from UHC. The ERS does not send out health or prescription drug cards to Medicare members. If you do not receive the two cards by December 31, 2018 please contact UHC at **1-800-841-4901** or UHC MedicareRx Part D at **1-866-465-0572**.
- **MPS, MATC, MMSD, UNITED WATER SERVICES, AND VEOLIA RETIREES:** The ERS office **does not handle your health insurance**. Please do not call ERS with health insurance questions if you retired from one of the above listed agencies. If you have questions or concerns, you should call the agency directly.
- **POLICE AND FIRE RETIREES METLIFE VISION/DENTAL COVERAGE VIA SOURCE ONE (aka the "Retired Public Safety Officers Insurance Premium Deduction Program."):** The ERS office **does not administer this benefit**. If you have questions or concerns regarding this benefit, please call Source One at **414-220-9900**.

### Third Quarter Investment Update

The City of Milwaukee Pension Fund had a return of 2.7%, net of fees, in the third quarter of 2018. This outperformed the Fund's blended benchmark by 0.3%. Third quarter GDP growth in the U.S. came in at 3.5%, marking the sixth consecutive quarter of growth greater than 2.0%. Once again, this supported public equity markets, and the return for the Fund's public equity allocation was 3.8%, net of fees. The prospect of future interest rate increases continued to weigh on fixed income markets, but the Fund's managers were able to generate some nice outperformance, with a return of 0.7%, net of fees, that outperformed the benchmark by 0.6%. The Fund's absolute return asset class performed well, with a return of 2.0%, net of fees, as did Private Equity, with a return of 5.0%, net of fees. The Fund's real estate portfolio was up 2.8%, net of fees, in second quarter of 2018, which is the most recent quarterly data available. The market value of the Fund on September 30, 2018 totaled approximately \$5.42 billion, and the year-to-date return was 4.5%, net of fees.

**Seasonal Flu Shots**

The flu is a contagious illness caused by influenza viruses that affects millions of people each year and can lead to serious illness. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) advises that the best way to prevent the flu is by getting vaccinated each year.

**Q: Where can I get my flu shot and is it covered?**

**A: YES, FLU SHOTS ARE COVERED AT 100% (IF YOU HAVE CITY PLAN COVERAGE WITH UHC) with no co-pay, co-insurance or deductible (as part of preventive services under the Affordable Care Act).** There are several ways retirees covered under UHC Choice and UHC Choice PLUS plans can obtain this year's flu vaccine. UHC Choice/UHC Choice PLUS members should visit their doctors or other in-network providers. **Please note** that if members are seeing a provider for a non-preventive visit, they will be charged for the visit, but not the flu shot. A member may also visit a network Convenience Care Clinic, select retail pharmacy like Walgreens, CVS, Target, etc. or contracted flu shot providers. **Your December, 2018 benefit payment will be mailed on December 27th, made payable for December 28th. Direct deposit payment will be in your account on Dec. 28th. Replacement for lost November checks will begin on Dec. 10th.**
